



This Certificate is valid for a period of ONE year only (2025-2026).



**CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:**

- 1) The Garbage generated within the premises should be collected and disposed off properly by appointing required sanitary staff.
- 2) On any account, the Garbage should not be burnt.
- 3) The employees should be educated to prevent the usage of plastics in the premises and no one should bring plastic carry bags, use and throw Tumblers to the premises.
- 4) If any construction work is going on employee must put proper safety equipments like apron, helmet, gloves, shoes, etc....
- 5) If any company or Industries like textiles, cotton mills or any minor particles the employee should wear mask.
- 6) To ensure that no mosquitogenic environment in the campus under section 83 of TNPH Act, 1939.
- 7) N.O.C. (or) License for Building to be obtained under TNPH Act 1939 and Buildings Act 1965.
- 8) Fire Precautionary measures, and First Aid box, should be provided in the campus.
- 9) Sign Board regarding 'No Smoking Zone', 'Here Smoking and Spitting is an offence' should be exhibited in front of the premise.
- 10) This Certificate issued is liable to be cancelled at any time on infringement if any of the above said conditions and for improper maintenance of sanitation, improper maintenance of the building as well as toilets in the premises.
- 11) That if any of all above conditions are not satisfied the Certificate given will be automatically cancelled.
- 12) This certificate should be renewed every year.
